

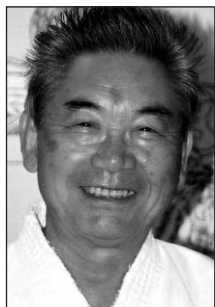
## ABOUT THE CAMP...

The annual Karate Training Camp has been offered by the University of South Alabama for the past 34 years. It is designed for any style karate student. The camp focuses on basic techniques, kata and sparring utilizing Shotokan style of karate.

Mr. Mikami will serve as Lead Instructor of this year's camp. Chief Instructor of the ASKA, he has served as a member of the World Karate Federation Technical Committee and as an instructor at WUKO Kata Course. USA Karate Federation Man of the Year in 1989, Mr. Mikami was selected as the Instructor of the Year by Black Belt Magazine in 1990.

Master Mikami was recently elected senior technical advisor to the Japan Karate Association. He is currently the founder, chief instructor, and chairman of the JKA American Federation. It is an affiliated member of the JKA World Federation in Tokyo, Japan

Mr. Mikami has dedicated his life and efforts to the internationalization of traditional Shotokan Karate-do. He came from the university system of modern Japanese Karate developed by the founder of modern karate, Gichen Funakoshi. The university tradition has been a dynamic base in the promotion of Shotokan Karate throughout the world. In particular, the USA Karate program originated more than 42 years ago.

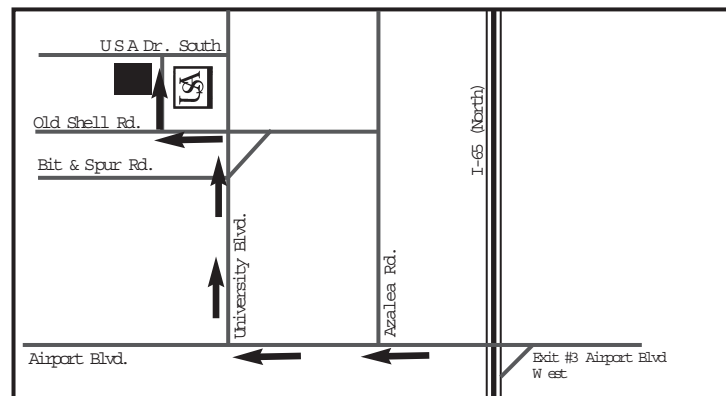
